(A) The Umatilla County Alcohol and Drug Program establishes an hourly “clinic cost” of service for all service types.

(B) This schedule is based on the customer's gross household income and size (number of individuals contributing to and dependent upon the household income) and identifies the “least rate” payable. Third party payers will be billed at “clinic cost.” Insurance co-payment is based on this “least rate” or the percentage remainder rate, whichever is less. The rate established will be the hourly fee charged for services. Applications for exceptions are available from program staff. *Exceptions must be supported by documentation and approved by the Department Program Manager.*

(C) No consumer will be denied service based on inability to pay.

(D) Consumers are charged per hour of service delivery time.

§ 39.617 FEE SCHEDULE SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

(A) Certain projects require significantly more resources of the county to review than other projects. Examples include, but are not limited to energy facilities, state or federal facilities, large scale developments, and projects with regional impact.

(B) These projects involve more resources of the Planning Department and other county departments due to their complexity and their overall impacts on the community. The demands placed upon the Planning Department in effect jeopardize the ability of the Department to meet other obligations such as processing local applications and completing routine planning activities.

(C) For these time-consuming and large-scale projects that require excessive departmental resources to review, the Planning Director may require the applicant to sign a memorandum of agreement to compensate the county for actual costs incurred to complete the review of a project and process an application in a timely manner. Funds obtained through the memorandum of agreement may provide a means for the county to retain extra temporary personnel, or to cover other personnel, administrative, travel, or materials costs.

(D) Therefore, if it is determined by the Planning Director at the time of initial application or at any time during the application process, that staff time and departmental costs to process a specific land use application will be greater than that of other similar applications, the Planning Director may require an applicant to enter into a memorandum of agreement with the county which would establish a fee based upon the actual; staff time and departmental costs.

(E) In terms of energy facility review, the Planning Director may require the applicant to sign a memorandum of agreement at any time after the Notice of Intent is filed with the Energy Facility Siting Council or the Department of Energy, or upon submittal of an application for local permits. If the state of Oregon Energy Facility Siting process, as defined in Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 345, at the date this section becomes effective is superseded, the county shall continue to retain authority to require a memorandum of agreement for local review of energy facilities.

(F) If an applicant refuses to enter into a memorandum of agreement or there is failure to negotiate an acceptable fee, the applicant may appeal the Planning Director's decision to the Board of Commissioners for resolution. If the applicant and the county fail to reach an agreement, the application will not be processed.

(G) In order to defray the costs of enforcing county ordinances, particularly the Solid Waste and Development Ordinances, the Director shall impose fees on those properties and owners of those properties which are found not to be in compliance with any county ordinance. The County shall charge a monthly enforcement fee for each property that meets the following conditions:

- (1) The property has been found to be in violation of a county ordinance;
- (2) The finding of a violation was not appealed to Circuit Court through a writ of review;
- (3) The property remains out of compliance with the violation cited and any subsequent notice(s) of violation.

The amount of the monthly enforcement fee shall be:

For properties with 1 to 4 dwelling units:	\$ 50.00
For properties with 5 to 20 dwelling units:	\$100.00
For properties with over 20 dwelling units:	\$150.00
For properties with all dwelling units unoccupied:	\$ 50.00
