A horsewoman, mother, and heavy-duty volunteer from Pendleton is the recent appointment as the 2010 chaperone for the Umatilla County Fair Court. Diane Cort-Wagner has been tapped to guide and supervise the young women who serve as royalty for the annual county summers' end celebration.

Cort-Wagner submitted her court chaperone application with the goal of supporting a program that has had a positive impact on her own family. "I have always felt dedicated to UCF and all its tradition," Cort-Wagener wrote. "The fair has shaped my children and helped them grow and become independent young adults."

The wife of Mike Wagner, Cort-Wagner has volunteered with 4-H, FFA, and the Pendleton Round-Up, as well as with Teen Screen and the Teen Suicide and Healthy Communities Coalitions.

Official kick-off for the fair is the first Saturday in August, but Cort-Wagner will be busy long before that as she assists in all aspects of court life ranging from royal appearances to behind-the-scenes work. Cort-Wagner's daughters have been involved in the county fair for years with the younger one eyeing a possible princess application in the next few years, according to mom. With that as a future possibility, Cort-Wagner's new chaperone post is a nice fit for the present.
