### **New service begins Tuesday, March 6**

Hermiston, Ore. – Looking for a place to ride your horse? The Umatilla County Fair has just the answer. Beginning March 6, it is offering a new service. For just \$5 per visit, people can ride in the arena between noon and dusk on Tuesdays.

No reservation will be required, but riders will be asked to sign a waiver on their first visit.

“We’ve tried to make it as easy as possible for folks,” said Peggy Clough Fairgrounds Manager.

Riders can sign up directly at the arena parking area. Kelli Kamm of Stanfield will be there to answer questions and show riders where to sign up and where the drop box for riding fees is located.

The Umatilla County Fairgrounds also has Stall Space available for overnight boarding for horses traveling thru the Hermiston area and on I-82 and I-84. It also has an RV park available for those pulling their trailers. Reservations can be made through the Fair office.
