as designated <sup>and</sup> described in the attached surveyors report, after a careful examination  
of the route of the proposed road, we the undersigned viewers have arrived at the  
conclusion that said road when opened will be of more than sufficient utility  
to justify the expenses which will have accrued in opening said road. Therefore Com-  
mended the opening of said Road.

Report of Survey to James Redford. O. P. Douglas & W. W. Weatherford. viewers appointed by  
the last term of the Hon: County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon. To view a  
road beginning at the Willows on the Columbia river about one <sup>and</sup> one half miles  
below the mouth of Willow Creek <sup>and</sup> intersecting the present road down Willow Creek about  
three or four miles from the mouth of said Willow Creek. To-wit: Beginning at  
the Willows on the Columbia river at a Willow six inches in diameter marked  
with the letter R. From which a Willow seven inches in diameter bears N. 42° E  
distance ten links. <sup>and</sup> from which another Willow bears S. 62° W. Distance <sup>in</sup> ~~ninety~~  
links, marked with three notches each. Thence S. 35° E. Distance Eight chains <sup>and</sup>  
fifty links, Thence S. 45° E. distance fifteen chains, thence N. 26° E. Distance  
thirteen chains, Thence N. 85° E. Distance twenty three chains <sup>and</sup> fifty links  
Thence S. 25° East, distance fifteen chains, Thence S. 33° E. distance five chains  
making one mile. To a stone marked one mile. Thence S. 11° E. distance fifteen  
chains. Thence S. 35 1/2° E. Distance thirty five chains Thence S. 44° E. Distance  
twenty two chains <sup>and</sup> fifty links, Thence South 61° E. Distance seven chains <sup>and</sup> fifty  
links. To a stake 4 in square marked two followed by the letter M. making two  
miles, Thence with said same Course. Distance Seventeen ~~ninety~~ chains <sup>and</sup> fifty links  
Thence S. 43 1/2° E. distance seven chains <sup>and</sup> fifty links. Thence S. 66° E. Distance twenty  
five chains. Thence S. 56° East. Distance ten chains. Thence S. 10° E. Distance five chains  
Thence S. three° West Distance seven chains, Thence S. 37 1/2° East, distance Eight chains  
to a stake four inches square marked three, followed by the letter M. <sup>and</sup> with the letter  
R. three miles. terminus of the road, also intersecting the present County Road  
running down Willow Creek. all angles of the road marked with stones or  
stakes. with the letter "A."
