## Viewers Report.

To Hon County Court Umatilla County, Oregon.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by your Hon Body to view out <sup>and</sup> report  
on the proposed change in County Road leading from S. E. cor Sec 30 T. 4 N.  
Range 33 East to intersect Pendleton <sup>and</sup> Centerville road. met <sup>and</sup> were duly qualified by  
J. H. Raley, Surveyor, as per order of Court, after having carefully viewed said pro-  
posed change as called for in petition of J. C. Arnold <sup>and</sup> David Ross across whose land said  
change is made we are of the opinion that said change as petitioned for is a much needed  
one, we believe the road can be made along said line as well as where it now runs,  
<sup>and</sup> that the distance will be shortened <sup>and</sup> the farms of said petitioners benefited thereby, we  
therefore recommend said change as indicated in petition <sup>and</sup> report <sup>and</sup> Plat of Surveyor  
hereunto attached

## Field Notes

To the Hon County Court Umatilla County, Oregon.

I submit the following as my report of survey of said change. I set post marked  
R. at a point 7 miles <sup>and</sup> 75 chains from commencement of said road as the initial  
point for said change. From said initial Post I ran South 26 chs 50 links cross  
Wild Horse Creek. South 1 chs 50 links set Post on Range line in center of County  
Road running up Wild Horse Creek, said post being marked "R" for terminus of  
said change. Total length of said change being 28 chains. A. J. Marsh <sup>and</sup> J. H.  
Ferguson were qualified by me as Viewers <sup>and</sup> Van Townsend after being qualified  
assisted, by myself carried chain, said proposed change, together with the  
old road are shown in the accompanying plat
