 Caplinger ^{and} L. M. Figg as Viewers, ^{and} Chairmen ^{and} Orva Caviness as marker, that
 under direction of said viewers, I proceeded to survey a County Road for the
 above named County ^{and} State, as described in the accompanying field
 notes of Survey.

 set post Miles 1. Angle N. 30 Deg E. 50 R. to line. thence N on line through
 center of Sec 23, 270 R to 1/4 Sec corner bet Sec's 14 ^{and} 23. Set Post Miles 2.
 thence N. 30 Deg E. 20 R. thence N. 30 Deg W. 20 R.
