Report of Viewers

We the undersigned having been appointed by your Hon body to view out and survey a change in a County Road leading from Umatilla up Butter Creek through David J Mitchells land, after being qualified according to law by A. L. Coffey, County Surveyor, we called to our aid John Mitchell and James Means as chainmen and D. M. Rinehart as marker, we proceeded to view out and relocate said road beginning at a point five chains and thirty links N 6° E of the 12 mile post and run on a southerly direction to intersect the old road.

We would further report, the change is a practical route and would recommend its adoption. This 7<sup>th</sup> day of Aug 1882,

§ 23° E 11.50 angle thence

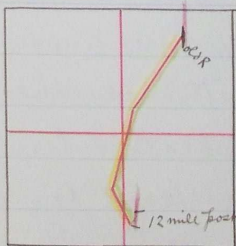
§ 11° W 35.50 Angle thence
