Report of Viewers. Field Notes<sup>and</sup> Plat of Survey of a Co Road Com. at S. E. cor of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sec 29 T. 4 S. R 32 E. ending at N. W. cor of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> S E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sec 24 T. 4 S. R 31 E.

## Report of Viewers.

To the Hon. County Court for Umatilla Co. Or.

We the undersigned viewers on County Road No 277 would report that we met with County Surveyor Jno C. Arnold at time<sup>and</sup> place appointed by your Hon. body, <sup>and</sup> proceeded to view out<sup>and</sup> survey said road as prayed for in the petition for the same; we find the road is located upon good ground, that the route is in every sense quite a practicable one, <sup>and</sup> the road is much needed, we therefore would recommend the same to be declared a public highway.

## Field Notes of the survey of County road No 277

At Alba in Umatilla County, Oregon on Nov 3<sup>d</sup> 1886 I met <sup>and</sup> qualified as per law in such case provided, R. H. Patton <sup>and</sup> James Rippey viewers, Rod McDonald <sup>and</sup> R. H. Vanhook chainbearers, Tho<sup>s</sup> J. Obenchain & R. J. Cox Axemen <sup>and</sup> markers.

I set initial post as per law at <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> on W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of line running E & W, through center Sec. 29 T. 4 S. R 32 East said point for <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cor as described. Having been found by P. Zahner, Opl<sup>y</sup> Co Surveyor 1885. Using a Solar Compass I run thence west by sun through center said Sec 29. Var. 20° E.

20.04 The <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> S. cor bet Sec 29 & 30. I am directed to find true line E & W, through center of Sec 30 T. 4 S. R 32 E. which I find as per law, <sup>and</sup> preserve copy of field notes of same. West on true line through center Sec. 30.

80.00 Set 1 mile post, as per law, about 30 feet north of line.

19.84 The <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> S. cor. W. bndy. Sec 30 on line bet ranges 31 & 32 E. Cut A on small pine tree, about 30 feet S. W. <sup>and</sup> run north on Sp. line

39.84 Cut A on small pine tree, about 30 feet S. W. of point, <sup>and</sup> run west along fence on N.

80.00 Set 2 mile post, as per law.

Cut A on mile post, <sup>and</sup> run thence north

20.09 Int. E & W. line 9 links east of <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> S. Cor. bet Secs 24 & 25 T. 4 S. R 31 E.

40.00 Set terminal post as per law about 8 feet west of line <sup>and</sup> about 250 links west of Mr. Cha<sup>s</sup> Humphrey's residence.
