Report of Viewers

Weston Or. Sept 27th 1887.

To the Hon. County Court for Umatilla Co. Or.

We, the undersigned viewers on County Road No 296
would respectfully report, that we met with the County surveyor
at Weston, Sept 26th 1887, and procured the assistance of W. A. Whitman
and Saml A. Crowell as chmn. and Henry Frazer as mkr, completed
the viewing out and surveying of said road 296. We find the road
to be needed, more especially by the people of Rees & Hawley
mountain and Weston and vicinities for an outlet to the mountains,
some grading will be necessary, but it will be on ground
free from rock, and will be quite easy; the road, when once
open will be easily kept in repair, the road, for the most part
is located on section lines, and where such is not the case, the
road is, in general, of much advantage to the owners of the land,
thus obviating any claims for damage, for these reasons we
would recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted
and road No 296 declared a public highway.

Field Notes of Road Survey 296 for Umatilla Co. Or.

Met viewers on road No. 296. at Weston, Aug 24th 1887. I set
initial post in mound at intersection of traveled roads in lanes
N. 48. and W. 653 feet south of the $\frac{1}{16}$ Sec. cor. on N $\frac{1}{2}$ of line bet. Secs
22 & 23 T. 4 N. R 35 E. and run thence on said line bet Secs. 22 & 23
ascend.

1500 Summit, Descend

2052 $\frac{1}{16}$ Sec. Cor. on S $\frac{1}{2}$ of line bet. Secs. 22 & 23.

2350 Foot of hill

3924 Cor. for Secs 22, 23, 26 & 27.

4100 Whitmans house on west.

5280 Det 1 mile post 20 east of line on E. side of lane.

1500 Descend to Pine Creek.

2600 Steep bank on N. side of P. Creek.

2650 Foot of bank - Pine Creek bottom

2975 Dry bed of Pine Creek, 21 ft wide. course W.

3310 Enter thick brush.
