Report of Viewers, Field Notes and Plat of Survey of a County Road, Comey on State Line and Geer Spring Road on line bet. Secs 17 & 20 T<sub>1</sub> S<sub>1</sub> R 35 E. 1/4 mile west of the East line of said Secs to intersect with Walla Walla and State Line Road.

Report of Viewers

To the Hon. County Court Umatilla County, Oregon.

We, the undersigned, viewers on County road No. 307, for Umatilla County and State of Oregon, would report that we met County Surveyor Jno C. Arnold at the time and place appointed for the same, and proceeded to view out and survey said road as prayed for and as specified in our several notices of appointment as viewers on said road. We found the section and subdivisional section lines were in doubt and confusion along the line of said road, and therefore ordered the Surveyor to locate same according to law in such case provided. We find the road located upon good ground, easily kept in good repair and now opened and traveled by the general public. We would therefore recommend that the prayer of said petitioners be granted.

Field Notes of the Survey of Road 307, U. Co. Or.

Pursuant to demand made by Ransom Wells and Louis Winters to locate section and subdivision lines and corners, to wit: Cor. for Secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21 in T<sub>1</sub> S<sub>1</sub> R 35 E; 1/4 Sec. Cor. on W 1/2 of line bet. Secs 17 & 20 in said T<sub>1</sub> S<sub>1</sub> R 35 E; 1/4 Sec. Cor. on W 1/2 of N. bndy. of Fractional Section 17 in said T<sub>1</sub> S<sub>1</sub> R 35 E.

I find spring branch, mentioned in original Field Notes as being 4.20 ch East of cor. for Secs 16, 17, 20 & 21 in T<sub>1</sub> S<sub>1</sub> R 35 E and measure West, on course indicated by the various lines of fencing, indicating Va. 18° 45' E.; I find original charred end of Gov. stake, about 18 inches below the ground surface; a smooth small boulder stone was placed above the end of the stake to mark locality of this cor, which is 4.40 ch west of branch referred to, - by W<sup>m</sup> A. Wells, three years ago. At this point, I set a basalt boulder 18x16x12 ins, marked 4 notches on E. and 3 notches on S. cor. Set in N. track of traveled road in lane, near Res. of Jno McDannald.

I run thence West on random line bet. Secs 17 & 20. 20.00 chs set temp 1/4 S cor. in road mouth of lane E & W 40.18 chs Int. N & S. line 5 3 links N. of old Gov. stake, which was found, in great state
