Report of Viewers, Field Notes and Plot of
Survey of Road No 292 in Umatilla County, Oregon,
Commencing at eight (8) mile stake on
county Road leading from Pendleton to John Day
Bridge, said stake being situated near the Southeast
corner of Henry Stovers farm in Umatilla County,
Oregon, from thence extending in a southerly direc-
tion on the most practicable route to the Base Line
Twenty (20) chains East of South west corner of
Section 35 Tp 1 NR. 32 E 1/4 M, from thence westward
as near the base line as Practicable to the North-
west corner of Sec 2, Tp 1 S. R. 32 E 1/4 M, thence
southerly as near section line as practicable to
South west corner of Section 23 Tp 1 SR. 32 E 1/4 M

To the Hon. County Court, Umatilla County, State of Oregon:
We the undersigned, Viewers in Road
Survey No. 292, respectfully report, that we met
with Jno. C. Arnold, County Surveyor at the time
and place designated by your Hon. body, and
proceeded to view out and survey said Road 292;
we find the road located upon section lines, and
upon good ground, upon which a road may be
easily kept in fine repair; fencing has, in most
part, been made with reference to the location
of said road in the way of lanes; the road is now
considerably traveled and much needed by the
petitioners and the general community.

We therefore recommend that said road as
viewed + surveyed be declared a public highway.
