Report of viewers, field notes and Plat of Road No 374 in Umatilla County, Oregon, commencing at the bridge across Wild Horse Creek on the line running north and south through the center of Section twenty-nine in township three North of Range 33 E. 1/4 M., in Umatilla County, Oregon, and thence run south to the section line running east and west between sections 29 and 32 in T. 3 N. R. 33 E. 1/4 M., thence running southwesterly down and along Wild Horse Creek on the south side of said Creek on the most practicable route to intersect the Range Line running north and south between Ranges 32 and 33, thence southwesterly on the most practicable route to the wagon road bridge across the Umatilla River about 3/4 mile above Pendleton and there ending. Said road to be forty feet wide.

In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out County Road No 374.

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County:

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No 374, submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met Jno. C. Arnold, County Surveyor, at Pendleton, on the 12th day of Oct. 1891, and were by him, each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We would therefore recommend that the prayer of the petitioners for said Road 374 be granted.
