Report of viewers, field notes and Plat of Road No 378
in Multnomah County, Oregon.

Commencing at the angle stake about 80 rods
East of the center of Section 22 T5 NR. 33 E Wm where road
No. 328 turns west on the line between the Northeast and
South east quarters of Section 22 T5 NR. 33 E Wm, thence run-
ning in a northern direction on the most practicable route
to secure a good road and good crossing over the O + W. J rail-
road tracks of the Y and Athens branch in the Vansycle
Canyon where the wagon road crossings of said track is now
located; thence along the east side of the right of way of the
O + W. J railroad so as to there connect with the said County
Road No 328.

In the matter of viewing, ^{surveying} and laying out County Road No. 378.
To the Honorable County Court, of the State of
Oregon, for Multnomah County;

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to
view and locate Road No 378, submit the following report;
