

Field Notes of Road Survey No. 413, for Umatilla Co. Or.

I met J. Stanscona and J. Schroeder, Viewers on R. No. 413, for Umatilla County, Oregon and Call Edgar Thomson and Adelbert Cargill to chain and mark after administering the usual oath to each. Under the direction of said Viewers I find pt. in Middle Cold Spring road. 921 ft. South and 1286 ft. West of the 1/4 Sec. Cor. bet. Secs. 21+22 T4 N. R 32 E 4th Set initial post, against fence on South side of lane Course E + W, 30 ft. S. of initial pt. near a public pump in said Cold Spring Canon from which said 1/4 Sec. Cor. bears N 51° 30' E about 1551 ft. and run from said pt. of commencing along road in lane.

- 1286" Int. line bet. Secs. 21+22 at pt. 921 ft. South of 1/4 Sec Cor.
- 1356" Center of narrow lane on S hdy. to Res of J. Cargill
- 1830" " " Cold Spring Canon, 20 ft wide Course W.
- 1912" Set A.P. Mk 1 in center of road in lane. Thence I run S 80° 55' E. along center of R. in lane
- 2914" Ravine 10 ft. wide Course S.E. bridged
- 4010" Set A.P. Mk 2, in center of road in lane. intersect center of road in lane thence N. Thence I run N 84° 05' E. along center of R. in lane
- 4510" Small ravine, 8 ft. wide, runs S.
- 5240" Set 1 M. P. against fence on S. side of lane.
- 1404" Int line bet. Secs 22+23 about 60 rods S. of Sec Cor. Set terminus terminus against fence on S. side of lane Course N 84° 05' E + S 84° 05' W.

All the posts were of regulation size and were correctly marked and set in earth mounds, and the road will in no part exceed a 10% grade
