Viewers Report

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon
for Wasatch County

We the undersigned the Viewers heretofore appointed
to view and locate Road No. 420 submit the following
report. Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we
met Jno C. Arnold County Surveyor at Res of James Trobaugh
on the 18th day of Apr. 1893 and were by him each duly
sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the
duties of our appointments. We called to our aid
James Trobaugh, Edgar Thomson Chairman Marker
who were by the Surveyor each, duly sworn. We
viewed, surveyed and located said road no 420 as
specified in our order we find the road located
upon better ground than the old or present
traveled road and the distance about the same
we would, therefore, recommend that the road as surveyed
be declared a public highway and that a correspond-
ing portion of the old or present traveled road be vacated
as per prayer of petitioners
