In the matter of Viewing Surveying laying out County Road No 429.

Comm at the 36th mile post on road No 277 on the Town Plot of Alba. thence in a general South easterly course on or near the present traveled road to the Northwest Corner of Section 4 Tps 32 Ewm
Thence Easterly on the most practical route to the old road grade, and down that to Camas Creek bottoms thence up Camas Creek to the Bowman Sheep Dip. thence along a road or trail already opened by the Deel Springs to the East line of Umatilla County, to a certain Pine Tree blazed on four sides, at or near the Summit, said road to be 60 ft wide from Section 4.

Viewers Report.

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County.

We the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No 429 submit the following report. Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court, we met Jno C Arnold County Surveyor at Alba Oregon, on June 26th A.D. 1893, and were by him, ^{duly} sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid Thos M. Revere, Edgar R. Thomson Chairman, Markers, who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No 429 as specified in our order.

We find that said Road No 429 as prayed for in said petition for same, and as viewed out surveyed and located by us, although in some parts requiring an amount of work to open, yet in our opinion no better route for a road between the points named could be found, and passing through a portion of the County where there are but few legal roads, and it appears to be needed by the general Public

We would therefore recommend that said Road No 429 become a Public Highway.
