In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out County Road No 474  
To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County,

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No. 474, submit the following report. Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met, John M. Kimbrell, Surveyor, at commencement of section Road No. 474 on Feb the 19<sup>th</sup> 1896 and were by him, each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid James Shockley, G. A. Wright, Chairman, J. M. Kimbrell, marker, who were by the Surveyor, each duly sworn, and viewed, surveyed and located said road No 474 as specified in our order and find the route practicable and would most respectfully recommend the same to be established as a public highway.

Field Notes of Road No 474

I commenced at the closing corner between sections 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> in Township 6 north of range 33 east W. 7th. on the state line between the state of Oregon and Washington. Set post 44 inches by 4 feet long in corner point 30 feet north of the initial point of Road marked R No. 474. Thence East 30 feet south and parallel with state line

- 594 a point 30 feet south of 15 mile corner on state line
- 3954 a point 30 feet south of 14 sec. cor.
- 8000 a point 30 feet south of the closing corner bet. Secs. 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> a stone 12x18x24 I marked 1, 2nd.
- Thence East 733 a point 30 feet south of 15 mile cor. on state line
- 7815 a point 30 feet south of closing corner of 14 sec.
- 7915 a point 30 feet south of the closing corner sec. 13 & 14
- 8000 set post 4x4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet north marked 2 M. dug pits and raised mound.
- Thence East 830 a point 30 feet south of 16 mile corner on state line
- 8000 set post 4x4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet north marked 3 M. dug pits and raised mound around post.
- Thence East 883 a point 30 feet south of the 17 mile post on state line
- 8000 set post 4x4 inches 4 feet long 30 feet north marked 4 M. dug pits and raised mounds around post.
- Thence East 3725  $\angle 1$  S 62° 5' E
- 3935  $\angle 2$  S 59° 50' E
- 4000 creek 60 lbs wide runs north.
- 4113  $\angle 3$  N 50° E
- 4244  $\angle 4$
- Thence East 8000 set post 44 inches 4 feet long 30 feet north
