We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate and change Road No 124, submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met John W Kimbrell, surveyor, at Kelie, on the 16th day of May, 1898, and were by him each duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointment.

We called to our aid A Knight, Ness Grover, Chairman, A Drysdale marker, who were by the surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed surveyed and located & changed said road No 124 as specified in our order and find the route to be practicable, the distance not materially increased and would most respectfully recommend the route established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon, as it has been continuously traveled by the public for the past several years.
