

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

In the Matter of Viewing, Surveying)
and Laying out of County Road No. 668)

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County:
Wee, the undersigned board of county road viewers, heretofore instructed to view,
survey, and locate road No. 668, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at Commencing of said
road on the 25 day of May, 1909.

We called to our aid: J. E. Bennett, Chainman; Adam Noble, chainman; A. B. Noble,
flagman; J. W. Kimbrell, marker; who were by the surveyor each duly sworn. We view,
surveyed, and located said road No. 668 as specified in our order. We find said route
practicable and would most respectfully recommend the same be established and declared a
public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon. The cost of construction to place said road in
condition for travel will be about \$180.00 to be at expense of petitioners. The property
of A. J. Sturtevant through whose land the said road is locatec by reason of the estab-
lishment of said road will be less valuable in the sum of \$127.50 (the cost of material
for fencing, 3 wires and post 16 1/2 feet apart). The property of D. Belts through whose land
the said road is located by reason of the establishment of said road will be less valuable
in the sum of \$214.30 (the cost of material for fencing, 3 wires and post 16 1/2 feet apart.)
The lands of _____ Henderson through which said road is located by reason of the establish-
ment of said road will be rendered less valuable in the sum of \$222.65 (the cost of
material 3 wires and post 16 1/2 feet apart.) The lands of _____ etter, A. B. Noble, _____
Scott, through whose land the said road is located by reason of the establishment of said
road will be rendered less valuable in the sum of nothing.
