to US paid, ha ve bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto

Umatilla County

the following described premises, to-wit:

a strip of land fifteen feet wide extending from East corner to the West Corner along the North side of the following described land, in Umatilla County, Oregon, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the North and South division line between the lands of Solomon Dinges and Wm. Stolte, distant $937 \frac{1}{2}$ feet South on said boundary line from its intersection with the Oregon State Line (said point of intersection being 122 feet West measuring on said State line from the stone monument locating the point where the West line of Section 15 Township 6 North Range 35 E. W. M. intersects said line) thence South on said Division line between the lands of Solomon Dinges and Wm. Stolte $256 \frac{1}{2}$ feet to a point; thence East 441 feet to a point; thence Northwesterly $258 \frac{46}{100}$ feet to a point distant $408 \frac{14}{100}$ feet East of the place of beginning, thence West $408 \frac{14}{100}$ feet to beginning, containing $2 \frac{1}{2}$ acres in Sections 15 and 16 in Township 6 North, Range 35 E. W. M. Also commencing at a point on the Oregon State line 122 feet West of the intersection of the Section Line between Sections 15 and 16 in Township 6 North, Range 35 E. W. M. with the Oregon State line, thence running South $937 \frac{1}{2}$ feet, thence East 408.14 feet, thence in a Northwesterly direction to a point on the Oregon State line 288 feet East of the point of beginning, containing $7 \frac{1}{2}$ acres of land situated in Sections 15 and 16 Township 6 North, Range 35 E. W. M.
