

TRUSTEES' RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Edwin Winter, Earl Gillanders and George A. Hartman as executors and trustees under the last will and testament and of the estate of John Vert, deceased, and by virtue of the authority vested in us under said will, in consideration of the sum of \$20.00 to us paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon a right-of-way for public road situate in said Umatilla County and described as follows:

A strip of ground for highway purposes 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line, the point of beginning being on the East and West divisional line between Sections 12 and 13 in Township 3 North of Range 35 East of the Willamette Meridian, 377.0 feet more or less West of the Northeast corner of Section 13 in said township and range, at Engineer's Station 25/42.8; thence South  $46^{\circ} 54'$  West a distance of 261.2 feet; thence around a  $26^{\circ}$  curve to the left (radius of 220.4 feet), the long cord of which bears South  $2^{\circ} 27'$  West a distance of 326.5 feet; thence South  $37^{\circ} 59.8'$  East a distance of ~~78.7~~ feet; thence around a  $10^{\circ}$  curve to the left (radius of 573.0 feet), the long cord of which bears South  $45^{\circ} 57'$  East a distance of 159.2 feet; thence South  $53^{\circ} 54'$  East a distance of 37.6 feet; thence around a  $20^{\circ}$  curve to the right (radius of 286.5 feet), the long cord of which bears South  $41^{\circ} 24'$  East a distance of 125.1 feet; thence South  $28^{\circ} 53'$  East a distance of 23.8 feet; thence around a  $20^{\circ}$  curve to the left (radius of 286.5 feet), the long cord of which bears South  $35^{\circ} 30'$  East a distance of 66.2 feet; thence South  $42^{\circ} 07'$  East a distance of 215.3 feet; thence around a  $100^{\circ}$  curve to the right (radius of 57.3 feet), the long cord of which bears South  $0^{\circ} 15'$  East a distance of 84.8 feet more or less to the Northeasterly boundary line of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, said point being 127.4 feet West of and 1071.3 feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 13 in said township and range, and containing 1.9 acres more or less.

To have and to hold such right-of-way unto the said Umatilla County for the purpose of a public road forever.
