Report of Viewers. Field notes and Plat of Survey of a County Road, commencing at the North West Corner of the North West quarter of Section 30 T5 N R 33 E W M. thence East One mile to intersect with County Road. Running North and South. Said Road to be on the line between Sections 19 and 30 T5 N R 33 E W M. and terminating at Point of intersection with Road running North and South.

Report of Viewers.

We, the undersigned, Viewers in the matter of Road Survey No 331, for Umatilla County, Oregon, would report that we met Jno. C. Arnold, County Surveyor, at the time and place appointed for the same, and were each duly qualified by him. We called to our aid L. M. Fuson marker, and A. E. Rest, and Christopher Anderson, chainbearers, and forthwith proceeded to lay out said road as described in our order. We find the road located upon a Section line, throughout its length, and upon comparatively good ground. The road appears to be greatly needed, as at present the travel near it is through a field of growing grain. We would therefore recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted, and that said road No. 331, become a County Road.

Field Notes of Road Survey No 331, for Umatilla Co. Oregon

I met Wm. C. Kern and J. H. King, viewers, at residence of L. M. Fuson, South Juniper 1 P.M. Wednesday, April 23^d 1890. And administered to each the usual Road Viewers Oath.

We called to our aid A. E. Rest, and Christopher

Anderson, as chainbearer, and E.M. Fuson, Marker, who were each duly qualified as directed by Law.

I. Commence at NW Cor of Sec 30 T5 NR 33 E, setting initial post 30' West of point of commencing, and with a Burt's Compass adjusted to Magnetic Meridian. I run S 84° 10' E. Ascend along fence claimed to be on Sec line
(Var 20° E)

- 2087 ft. Summit
- 2000 " Ravine. SW - no Culvert necessary. Ascend gently.
- 2230 " Channel 3 1/2 ft wide - needs culvert.
- 2600 " 1/4 S Cor. bet. Secs 19 & 30 exact point shown by E.M.F. From this point, an old ditch fence runs S 85° 35' E and a wire fence runs N 84° 10' W.
- 3550 " Summit
- 5254 " Fence on West side of land N & S
- 5308 " " " East " " " "

Set terminus at this point, against fence on E side of lane - All the posts used, are of the dimensions, and marked and set in mounds as required by law.
