Know all men by these presents, That J. W. Terry, an unmarried man,

paid to him, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Conuty of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Eighty (80) feet wide, being Forty (40) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of section 13, Township 2 North, Range 33 East, W.M. and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a point which is 30.1 feet north and 172.9 feet east of the southwest corner of saction 13, T. 2 N., R. 33 E. W. M.; thence north 33° 59' west a distance of 262.2 feet; thence north 0° 21' east a distance of 141.8 feet; thence south 33° 59' east a distance of 424.7 feet to the north right of way line of the present county road; thence north 89° 39' west along said right of way line a distance of 96.8 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing .63 acres, more or less.
