paid to them the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet wide on each side of the following described center line as surveyed across the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, T. 3 N. R. 33 E. W.M.; Beginning at a point 348 feet west of the Quarter Section corner common to Sections 20 and 29, thence South 19° 18' West, 0.0 feet, thence on a 10 curve left, 177.9 feet, thence South 1° 31' West, 141.7 feet, thence on a 12 curve left, 285.0 feet, thence South 32° 41' East, 305.8 feet, thence on a 6 curve right, 524.7 feet to a point on the section line, 1337 feet South of the Quarter Section corner common to Sections 20 and 29. All in Township 3 North, Range 29 East, W.M. Also; Beginning at a point 291 feet north of the Center of Section 29, thence South, 0.0 feet, thence on a 16 curve right, 180.3 feet, thence South 28° 51' West, 4.4 feet, thence on a 12 curve left, 124.4 feet to a point on the Quarter Section line, 92 feet West of the Center of Section 29, All in Township 3 North, Range 33 East, W.M.
