NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the following legal description replace the legal description on Order No. RD95-013:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PARCEL TO BE OBTAINED BY UMATILLA COUNTY

A parcel of land located in the northeast 1/4 of Section 19, Township 4 North, Range 28 East of the Willamette Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 2-inch iron pipe marking the Initial Point of Tract "A" of the Westland Estates Subdivision; thence S44°03'41"W, 101.25 feet along the easterly right of way line of Westland Road to a 5/8" iron pin; thence S63°43'24"E, 80.35 feet to the westerly right of way line of Agnew Road and a 5/8" iron pin; thence N0°51'57"W, 108.34 feet along the westerly right of way line of Agnew Road to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 0.09 acre, more or less.
