WHEREAS, We, the undersigned are the owners of all of the hereinafter described route for a county road, and Whereas, we are desirous of having a forty foot county road established on the herein described route in Umatilla County, State of Oregon; which said road is proposed to be located as follows, to-wit;

A strip of land forty (40) feet in width, being twenty (20) feet on each side of and parallel with a center line described and located as follows; said center line beginning at the city limits of Echo, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, at the South end of an unnamed street in the said City of Echo, at a point ten (10) feet East of the SW. corner of the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section sixteen (16) Township three (3) North, Range twenty-nine (29) East W. M., said point being twenty (20) feet Southwesterly and at right angles with the O. W. R. & N. Co. right-of-way;

Thence South 31°-45' East, twenty (20) feet distant from and parallel with said O. W. R. & N. Co. right-of-way two thousand five hundred and sixteen (2516) feet four (4) inches, more or less, to intersect the county road at the East line of the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section twenty-one (21), Township three (3) North, Range twenty-nine (29) East W. M.
