We run Va. 21° E.

- West 19 50 intersect Town line between R 35 & 36 E and planted a post for S. W. corner there
- North 39 27 Set post on 1/4 sec line 1/2nd the Bathing lung duly qualified as chainman commencing at 1/4 sec post on the North boundary of sec 30 T4 N R 36 E from which we run
- West 14 50 an established Government corner with bearing trees from said corner we run
- South 36 50 intersect 1/4 sec line returning to 1/4 sec post on South boundary of sec 30 we run
- North 66 39 50 Set post for center of Sec 30 from which we run
- 38 50 1/4 sec post on North boundary sec 30

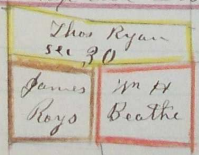
