 said Sec. found said corner in a good state
 of preservation with mound etc, from which I run
 set temp $\frac{1}{4}$ post on N + S line in center of Sec
 set $\frac{1}{4}$ post on South line of Sec - I then went
 to the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the East line of said Sec + run
 Imatada River 1 chm wide
 set $\frac{1}{8}$ post
 set temp $\frac{1}{4}$ Post in center of Sec
 Cross Imatada River
 set temp $\frac{1}{8}$ Post
 returned the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the West
 line of said Sec 9 Post mound and
 pits are all plain + well defined
 I returned to the center of said Section
 and set permanent center post at the
 intersection of the East + West + North
 and South lines Both lines were Blazed
 through indicating their location.
