Run at request of Adams Bros  
September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1850

After having qualified  
Geo J Berry and Jonathan Talbot as chainmen  
I proceeded to Survey the above named sec  
as follows The NW Cor of Sec 12 as marked  
by the original survey being well defined I  
went to said corner + Ran to Random line  
In trees described in original field notes I  
found stump of tree designated in said  
notes as being North 42° W 26 links dist  
with Gov Marks plainly visible Another is  
described as being S80°E 46 links distant  
I found a tree corresponding and after chopping  
5 inches into said tree I incored Government  
marks 1/4 S therefore finding trees as described in  
the original field notes I set the 1/4 post from  
said trees as designated in the field notes  
From said corner I run on a true line
