285°10' West on random line bet sec 13 & 24 25 N 16 36 6

20 00 set Simpson 116 cor

40 72 the 1/4 sec cor bet sec 13 & 24 as shown to by J M Willard an old settler and knows the point of original cor to be on this curved line as the fences are now in place built from cor to corner

thence N 85°11' 0 on same line

20 36 set Stone for 1/4 cor

40 72 the cor to sec 7-18-13 8 24

from the 1/4 sec cor bet sec 13 & 24 1 run

N 86°15' 14 on random line bet S 1/4 sec 13 & N 1/4 sec 24

40 20 a point 36 1/2 ft south of cor to sec 13-14-23 8 24

thence S 86° 6 on same line

40 20 the 1/4 sec cor bet sec 13 & 24
