60.00 Set temp. stake.

80.00 Set stake in Alfalfa field and turn angle of 91° 14' and run on Random towards South. Point Kimbrell found when he surveyed his tract in 1861 and 60 ch. East of this point.

20.00 Set temp. stake

40.00 Set temp. stake

60.00 Set temp. stake.

80.00 Set stake which is 130 ch. N of cor. post of fence and 160 ch. East. No cor. found. Chain on South post.

40.14 Old 1/4 sec. post found rotted in hole. Came back to Sec. Cor. and chained East along fence.

40.02 Cor. of fence.

80.22 Old Gov. cor. post in Marine to cor. of Sec. 26-27-34-35 and as this nearly agrees with other links with the old measure I establish the Sec. Cor. to Sec. 27-28-34-33 at the fence cor. post by marking it and driving an iron bar 15" in the ground of 1" diameter. A fence post 18" dia. bears East 32 links.

Then as near as I could figure it with out a sight on the sun the bearing of the sec. line bet. Sec. 27-28 would be N 0° - 05' E. which I run from the established cor. marking the

40.00 2d temp. 1/4 stake. mixed 136 ch. S and 0.55 ch. W. Set post with brick buried marked 1/4 Sec. Cor.

60.00 3d temp. 1/16 cor. stake mixed 106 ch. S and 0.38 E. Set post with brick buried marked 1/16 cor.

21.10 40.00 temp. Sec. Cor. mixed 179 ch. S. and dug hole and buried 3 bricks on and marked Sec. Cor. in Alfalfa for cor. of Sec. 27-28-21-22. Then as the error in the N line was 0.80 ch. and the angle

turned 91° 14' the corrected angle would be 91° 20' and the bearing of N line N 88° 10' W which I run

20.25 set temp. 1/16 stake. 142 ch. S. and set post marked 1/16 cor. with brick buried in hole.

10.00 set temp. 1/4 stake 95 lks. S. and set post marked 1/4 cor. with bricks buried in hole.

60.00 set temp. 1/16 stake 49 lks. S. and set post marked 1/16 cor. with brick buried in hole.

38.00 4" x 4" white post for Cor. to Sec. 29-29-22-23. Thence I run S 0° - 41' W

21.95 temp. stake

40.00 temp. stake

60.00 temp. stake

88.40 temp. stake. No Sec. Cor. found so chain W.

80.14 4" x 4" white sec. cor. post.

Note - Chained on this to base line of township on Aug 27 and found this sec. is long by 188 ft. so I divided this making each mile 5274 ft.

As this measurement agrees nearly with the old Gov. measurement and it is on the fence line I establish the sec. cor. to Sec. 28-29-32-33 at this last stake point and set a post marked Sec. Cor. with a brick buried in the hole. I then go back and set a post with a brick buried in the hole for each of the $\frac{1}{16}$ cor. and the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. and mark then $\frac{1}{16}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ cor.

Thence ~~589~~ 715 S 89° 45' E.

- 20.33 Set post marked $\frac{1}{16}$ cor. for. cor. and buried brick in hole.
- 40.66 Set post and buried brick in hole for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. Sec. 28. 33
- 60.99 Set post and buried brick in hole for $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor.
- 81.30 Cor. to sec. 27-28-33-34.

Thence starting at the N $\frac{1}{16}$ cor. bet. Sec. 28-27 I run N 89°-11' W

and set a post with brick in hole marked $\frac{1}{16}$ cor. for center of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.

Thence N 0°-23' W -

80.00 E $\frac{1}{16}$ cor. bet. Sec. 22-28 as all ready set.
