

Survey for Sim Dickenson - Sect. 8 - T 5 N R 34 E.

Chains Links

After having qualified J.D. Cleranger I started at the Sect. Cor. of Sect. 4-5-8-1
which is a rock buried in $\frac{1}{2}$ of road set by Winkle and described in Bradley's survey

No. 409. I run South $0^{\circ}26'W$.

37 65 a point opposite rock marked X set by Surveyor for Mike Ryan.

71. 68 fence cor. - runs S + N. Sworn to by A.B. McEwen to Kimbrell in 1906 as being put where
the original cor. was, to Sec. 8-9-16-17

Starting at fence cor. I run $S 8^{\circ}30'E$

81. 43 a point on line with $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lane W. said to have been on line with Sec. Cor.

Thence starting at fence cor. ²⁹⁻⁶⁻⁹ I chain E.

83. 30 to rock marked X on N 7.5. fence line - (line E - 10' S.) said to be old cor.

I set up inst. and run $N 86^{\circ}00'W$

83. 30 to fence cor.

Then I run $N 0^{\circ}26'E$ 35.86

35 86 Set Rock - drive stake and make mound of rock for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor.

Thence I run West. ($N 89^{\circ}34'W$)

40. 40 and drive stake and make Stone Mound for center of Section. 30' W. of creek in farm.
