DESCRIPTION: The Corrections Officer shall have the responsibility of following Umatilla County Corrections Division (UCCD) Policies and Procedures governing the general functions of UCCD and its inmates. The Corrections Officer is a sworn position assigned to the Corrections Division by the Sheriff. The Corrections Officer participates in the daily functions of the correctional facility and supervises all incarcerated inmates.
