

3. Sexually Transmitted Disease Clinic
 - a. Provide on-site testing for exposed individuals (blood, cervical, urethral, throat, rectal specimen collection). (EE)
 - b. Onsite lab services (KOH, PH, and urine specimen). (EE)
 - c. Route specimens to appropriate lab sites. (EE)
 - d. Provide treatment or referral of positively diagnosed individuals. (EE)
 - e. Provide preventive education to individuals and groups. (EE)
 - f. Investigate and control community outbreaks. (EE)
4. Communicable Disease Investigation
 - a. Investigate and control outbreaks/potential outbreaks. (EE)
 - b. Provide testing and treatment of exposed individuals. (EE)
 - c. Route specimens to appropriate lab sites. (EE)
 - d. Consult with local health providers. (EE)
 - e. Serve as an informational resource to the community. (EE)
5. Completion of monthly, quarterly and annual reports as required by the division and the Oregon State Health Division. (EE)
6. Assist with orientation of new staff. (EE)
7. Establish and maintain professional, respectful, and effective working relationships with management, supervisor, other employees, and clients. (EE)

OTHER DUTIES OF POSITION

Backup for staff nurses at all clinic sites; backup for front desk; weekly cleaning of labs and exam rooms; other duties as necessary and assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

PHN I: Graduation with an A.D.N. from accredited school of professional nursing.

PHN II: Graduation with a B.S.N. from an accredited school of professional nursing; or A.D.N. and four (4) years public health experience and/or combination of education and experience.

PHNIII: Graduation with a B.S.N. from an accredited school of professional nursing and four (4) years public health experience or B.S.N. with a master's degree in a related field.

PHN I, II, III: Current Oregon Registered Nurse license; valid Oregon driver's license with satisfactory driving record; bilingual desired; ability to work with clients of varying ages, gender, race, ethnicity, religious and social background; ability to work under minimal supervision. These assignments are non-competitive and promotions are appropriate upon satisfactory completion of tenure or college degree.
