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SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER ROAD LEGALIZATION REPORT

HISTORY

The South Fork Walla Walla River Road was originally established as road No. 503 in 1898 (see attached field notes and plat). It was established from a point in what is now County Road No. 610 (Walla Walla River Road) and ran southeasterly for 7 miles to the west line of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 37 E.W.M. where it terminated. Over the years the portion of the traveled road from the end of the county road to its crossing of the South Fork of the Walla Walla River in Harris Park obtained public road status, evidently through prescriptive methods, although early surveys around the mid-1950's showed it as a county road. The Umatilla County Board of Commissioners accepted this section of the road as a county road in 1991.

GENERAL

The legal description of the road accepted as a county road in 1991 was based on using bearings and distances from 2 older surveys. Evidently no field surveying was done to determine whether the description matched the actual location of the road. The attached ownership maps show that it doesn't match very well. Also, one of the older surveys that was used not only for writing the description, but to describe several of the property boundaries in the area shows the road at a width of somewhat less than 40 feet, indicating that the road location was surveyed and property boundary monuments set giving very little room between edge of traveled road and property lines. Monuments found along the title lines in the survey for this legalization bear this out.

IMPACTS TO UTILITIES AND PROPERTY OWNERS

The only existing utilities in the area are telephone lines buried in the shoulder of the road. Power is supplied via overhead lines and the lines and poles are on private property within private easements. No immediate impacts to the phone lines is anticipated. Should the road be widened and improved, the phone lines will have to be moved closer to the right-of-way lines.


No major encroachments buildings or other structures owned by abutting property owners exist. Some fence lines are very close to the edge of the shoulder and would have to be removed at the time of any road improvements, as would some brush. Some of the fences are currently in a poor state of repair.


STATUTES


ORS 368.201(3) provides a basis for the county governing body to initiate legalization proceedings if a road as traveled and used for 10 years or more does not conform to the location of a road described in county road records.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Department recommends that the road be legalized as shown on the attached survey map and as described in the final order at a width of 40 feet outside of Harris Park and 60 feet within Harris Park.

Whereas, the Umatilla County Roadmaster has determined that, Umatilla County would benefit by making said public road part of the Umatilla County Road System since said public road is a continuation of County Road #600 and gives access to Harris Park on the South Fork of the Walla Walla River, said road described a follows:

Beginning at a brass cap monument at the Northeast corner of the Pacific Power and Light Company property, said monument bearing North 63°43′55" West a distance of 4,493.43 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 37 East, W.M. as recorded in Deed Book 297, Page 574.

Thence North 593 feet; Thence West 914 feet to the Northwest corner of a rock-wall shed as mentioned in the Deed from Margret S. Colman to Percy A. Larsen et ux recorded in Book 266, Page 463 Records of Umatilla County, Oregon; Thence North 73°13' West. 41.66 feet; Thence South 54°49' West, 314 feet; Thence North 53°09' West, 64.1 feet; Thence North 0°13' East, 584.47 feet to the true point of beginning, said true point of beginning being on the West line of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 37 East, W.M.; Thence on the centerline of said road South 64°47' East, 193.62 feet; Thence South 63°41' East, 189.94 feet; Thence South 52°15' East, 124.68 feet; Thence South 58°23'45" East approximately 665.14 feet to the center of road 20 feet from the Northwest corner of the "Kirk Place" as mentioned in Deed Records Book 207, Page 305.

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
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
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
SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners to define the location of the traveled road from the west line of Section 10 to the Walla Walla Ralyer for a road legalization and from the Walla Walla Raiver to the easterly Harris Park boundary for the purpose of re-classifying it from an interior park road to a county road. Raiph Thompson surveyed the south line of what is now Tax Lot 3000 in 1971. Bill wells surveyed the park boundary in 1995, setting the southeast corner of Section 10 (from which most of the property descriptions in the area originate) and found a discrepancy of approximately 165 feet in distance and 9 degrees in bearing between his measurements and Thompson's measurements from the corner to other found monuments in the sea. There was also a discrepancy of approximately 46 feet in distance and 3 degrees in bearing between Wells' measurements and those shown on a 1956 survey by Thompson's distance and bearing from the southeast corner of Section 10 to the northeast corner of what is described in deads as the PP and L Tract (now owned by the Kraemera) was used as a course in the description of a public road that was accepted as a county road by the Board of Commissioners in 1991 (Reel 209, Pages 1329-1331, Deed Records). Also used in the road description were bearings and distances along the road from Newbill's Survey by mane than 2 degrees, though no correction (rotation) was made to either of the surveys when the courses were combined in the description. 





SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY SURVEY





SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER ROAD PROPERTY OWNERSHIP MAP
