

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

We the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view and locate said proposed road, beg to submit the following report:

Pursuant to your order we met at the beginning point of said road on the 19th day of February 1918.

The viewers each having been duly qualified we proceeded to view and locate said proposed road as specified in our order.

We find said route practicable, and being a route having easy grades is much needed as an outlet to the Course creek water-shed, as the only present outlet is over hill roads having very steep grades. We would therefore most respectfully recommend that the said proposed road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The lands of C. E. Hadley lying on the north side of the Walla Walla river and east of the center line of said road is rendered less valuable to the amount of \$200.00

The lands of Anna (Siofke) Olinger lying on the north side of the Walla Walla river and west of the center line of the said road is rendered less valuable to the amount of \$200.00.

The lands of Chas. L. Stewart, in consideration of the benefits accruing to said lands on account of the establishment of said road is rendered less valuable to the amount of nothing.

In consideration of the benefits accruing to lands of Susan H. Coe, H. W. Williams, Mary A. Williams, A. R. Shunway and H. M. Cockburn on account of the establishment of said road, the

said lands of said parties are rendered less valuable in the amount of nothing. And in further consideration of the benefits accruing to the lands of parties interested in the use of said road we recommend that the said parties be required to do all earth grading in the construction of said proposed road.
