

NW County Court January term 1883  
10<sup>th</sup> Judicial day Friday Jan'y 12<sup>th</sup>

Road, as follows,

Commencing at the terminus of the County Road at the Alby Cabin in  
Camas prairie thence running about ten miles in a southerly  
direction along the most practicable route crossing the north Forks of  
John Day River at or near Smeads Bar. to a point on the County  
line between Umatilla and Grant Counties where the proposed  
road running from Daffy's Springs in Grant Co to the north Forks of  
John Day River intersects said county line.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that W<sup>m</sup> Howard James Rippey  
and E B Gamble be and they are hereby appointed viewers and  
A L Gaffney Surveyor to view locate and survey said  
proposed Road and report their doings therein to this Court at the  
April 1883 term thereof and that they meet at the Alby Ranch at the  
beginning of said proposed road on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1883  
and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf

Now on this day comes the report of L. Bowler, O. Hartness  
and J. Willard, heretofore appointed by this Court as viewers to view and  
assess the damage sustained to the lands of N Ford, by reason of  
the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road  
as prayed for in his petition for damages, which said report awards and  
estimates the damage sustained to the lands of N Ford by the location of  
said proposed county road through said N Fords lands at the sum  
of \$120<sup>00</sup>

Also comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed by this Court to  
to view and locate said proposed road as a County road for final hearing the same  
having been read over previous day of this term of this Court to wit Jan'y 1883 term and  
said viewers having reported favorably recommending the establishing of the  
same as a County Road and the field notes & plat of survey duly on file and  
certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established  
and located as a County road in an ordinance with the report, field notes  
& plat of survey filed herein upon the payment by the Petitioners herein  
to said N Ford of the sum of \$120<sup>00</sup> as awarded him as damage by said  
viewers aforesaid and that upon the satisfaction of said sum having been paid  
being filed with the Clerk of this Court by the Petitioners, the Clerk of this Court  
will duly record said report, field notes & plat of survey as by law required and that the  
supervisors through whose district said road runs pay the same for public use
