On the matter of the location of a County Road
 commencing at a point on what is
 known as Crow's Road where it crosses Pine Creek

Now on this day comes
 the viewers report for a second reading which report was
 publicly read in open court on two different days of the same
 meeting, said road commencing at a point on what
 is known as Crow's Road, where it crosses Pine Creek, thence
 up the valley of said creek to the mouth of Lamar gulch
 thence up said gulch to the section line between sec. 5 & 6
 Township 4 N. R. 35. E. thence south to the S.E. corner of sec. 6.
 thence up the hollow to the north line of J. W. Stampers land
 claim thence east to the N.E. corner of said claim thence
 south 80 rods thence east 80 rods thence south 80 rods thence
 east 80 rods to the half mile stake on north line of sec. 16
 thence south two miles thence east 80 rods thence south half
 a mile thence east till it intersects the County Road
 leading from Weston to Dr. Perkins - There being a remon-
 strance on file, but the Court being satisfied that
 there is a greater number of names on the petition of
 persons that live directly on the line of said road, than appears
 on the remonstrance of persons that live directly on the line
 of the road. It is now therefore ordered by the Court, that
 said road be opened and declared a public highway
 in accordance with the viewers report, survey and plat
 on file. The Supervisor of said road district being requi-
 red to open said road and keep the same in repair.
