paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in
the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty(60) feet wide, being Thirty(30) feet on

each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across Section 4
Township 3 North, Range 35 East Willamette Meridian. Said center line being more part
icularly described as follows; Beginning at a point known and designated as Station 173
49.1 of said survey which point is 1735 feet South and 1320 feet East of the Northwest
Corner of Section 4 Township 3 North, Range 35 East Willamette Meridian. Thence, South
35 degrees 54 minutes East 680.2 feet. Thence, on a 1432.5 foot radius curve to the left
141.2 feet, Thence, South 41 degrees 33 minutes East, 851.1 feet, thence, on a 1432.5 foot
radius curve to the left 156.7 feet, thence, South 47 degrees 49 minutes East, 499 feet.
Thence, on a 318.3 foot radius curve to the left 234.3 feet, thence, South 5 degrees 39
minutes East 1.8 feet, Thence, on a 150.8 foot radius curve to the left 132.4 feet, thence
South 55 degrees 59 minutes East 346.2 feet to a point which is 1320 feet North and
2080 feet West of the Southeast Corner of Section 4 Township 3 North, Range 35 East
Willamette Meridian.
