TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA
 COUNTY:

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore
 ordered to view the above mentioned road, submit the following report;

Pursuant to your order, we met at the beginning point of the
 above mentioned road on the 14th day of July, 1927 and having qualified
 as viewers, proceeded to view the proposed road.

We find the road as located and surveyed to be feasible and
 necessary and that it will be a benefit to the public, therefore, we
 respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a County
 Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

We find that certain lands through which the proposed road is
 located will be made less valuable, by reason of its establishment as
