All that part of the property of J. M. Banister and Adrene Banister in Section 21, Township Four (4), North Range Thirty-five (35), E.W.M., included within a strip of land 60 feet wide being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Oregon-Washington Highway No. 8 as surveyed over and across said property and as more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of the present traveled County Road 1519.0 feet South 88° 12' West of the center of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Four (4), North Range Thirty-five (35), E.W.M., Umatilla County, State of Oregon; thence on a 7° curve to the right whose central angle is 31° 30' 450.0 feet; thence South 60° 18' East 1863.1 feet; thence on a 6° curve to the left whose central angle is 29° 11' 486.4 feet to a point on the center of the present traveled County Road to a point 1350.5 feet North and 1775.5 feet North 89° 29' West from the corner of Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, Township 4, North Range 35, E.W.M., said tract of land containing 3.86 acres of land more or less.
