

In County Court July term 1883
7th judicial day Wednesday July 11th

In the matter of County Road, commencing at the N.W. cor. of Sec 2, T. 3, N. R., 33, E. Thence running Westward along Spr line as near as practicable for a County road, to intersect a County road at the N.W. cor. of Sec 6, T. 3, R., 33, E.

Case No 144.

Now on this day comes the report of J. H. Ellis, W. P. Ketchum and Wm M Baker, the viewers heretofore appointed at the April 1883 term of this court. to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road, for final hearing. the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court, to wit July term, 1883 and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey of said road being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance being on file against said road,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that said road be established in accordance with said report and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be duly recorded as by law ^{required} and that the Road Supervisors through whose District said road passes be directed to proceed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

In the matter of a change in County Road } Road No 168
leading from Cold Spring to Pine Creek }

Now on this day comes the petition of A Rummey and 22 others praying the Court to appoint viewers and surveyor to view out and locate a change in the county road leading from Cold Spring to Pine Creek, as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the County road leading from Cold Spring to Pine Creek 200 yards south of the half mile stake on the East line of Sec 7, T. 3, N. R., 33, E. of N. W. on the land occupied by John Oton, running thence in a North Westerly direction to the South East corner of Rummey pasture, thence along the fence on the East side of said pasture to the N. E. corner of said pasture in Spring Gulch, thence in a North Easterly direction down said Gulch on the most practicable route on the E. side of said Spring Gulch to a point in said road leading from Cold Spring to Pine Creek, where said road crosses Spring Gulch to the six mile stake as set in the survey of said road - also to vacate all that portion of said County road
