8th Judicial Day Tuesday Sept 11th

Court met pursuant to adjournment, present the same officers as of yesterday, and after due proclamation of the opening of Court by the proper officers, the following proceedings were had.

In the matter of a change in a }
County Road through the lands }
of D. K. Smith }

Now upon this day comes the petitioner herein D. K. Smith and ask that the Court adopt the report of the viewers of said proposed change of County Road filed herein, and also comes Jno A. Guyer a resident and householder, and objects to the adopting of said report. And his written objections having been duly filed herein. The Court proceeded to consider the objections relating to the ownership of the land where change is asked for. (It being admitted that the change if allowed at all must be allowed on the private petition of D. K. Smith). The Court finds as facts that the land on which such change of road is prayed for, is what is generally known as Rail Road land, and is in the possession of D. K. Smith the petitioner, and on which he has permanent and valuable improvements but that he has no further title or interest than arises from these facts.

As a conclusion of law the Court finds that said petitioner is not the owner of said land as contemplated by the Statute giving the owners of land the right to petition for such change.

Wherefore it is ordered and adjudged that the petition for change of said road be denied and that the report of said viewers be rejected.

In the matter of a change in County Road } Road No 168
leading from Cold Spring to Pine Creek }

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed at the July term 1883 of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County road, for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit: September term 1883 and the viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey, being duly on file, and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court, that said road be established

as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required. That the Road Supervisor through whose district said road passes, proceed to open the same as a County Road
