

# ROAD NOTICE.

To All Persons Whom it May Concern:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the September term of said County Court, to-wit: on the 1 day of September 18 90, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing on state line at the 1/4 sec corner between secs 17 and 18 T6N. R32E. 40m. thence south 80 rods thence east 160 rods thence south 80 rods to 1/4 sec corner between secs 17 and 20 thence east ~~on~~ sec line about 140 rods thence follow fence around head of canyon <sup>to</sup> sec line between secs 20 and 21 thence south on sec line to 1/4 sec corner between secs 20 and 21 thence east about 110 rods thence south and follow wagon road as now traveled around head of canyon to the line between H Russell's and Alva Pierce's R.R. land thence south to 1/4 sec corner between secs 21 and 22 thence east one mile on sec line to 1/4 sec corner between secs 22 and 27 thence south to the center of sec 27 thence east to 1/4 sec corner between secs 26 and 27 T6N.

Said road to be 40 feet wide.
