Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road viewers heretofore instructed at the May 1913 term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed County Road NO. 751 petitioned for as commencing at the NW corner of Section 34, Tp. 34 E.W.M. thence southerly on the most practical route to the center of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 1 Tp. 1 N.R. 34 E.W.M. as a County Road for final hearing the same having been publicly read on 2 different days of the same term of Court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on June 4th, 1913, and publicly read the second time on June 5th, 1913, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against said report or petition

It is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the board of County Road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the record of plat and field notes of Umatilla County and that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County.
