Petition.

To the Honorable the County Court of Umatilla County,
State of Oregon.

We, the undersigned freeholders of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, residing within the territorial limits of the last divisional road district, or districts, which existed where said road hereinafter described is to be (located, laid out, relocated, or changed), as shown by the County Records of Umatilla County, Oregon, to-wit:

Road District Number 50 Reservation So. Reservation, respectfully petition your Honorable Body to locate, lay out and establish _____, a county road as follows, to-wit:

A road forty (40) ft wide, the center line of which is as follows:
Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the South east quarter of section twenty three (23), Township two (2), North, Range thirty three (33) E.W.M.; thence southwesterly along the most practical route to the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section twenty three (23); thence westerly (on the present fenced road) along the south line of sections twenty three (23), twenty two (22), twenty one (21), twenty (20), and nineteen (19), to the Southwest corner of section nineteen (19) Township two (2) N. Range Thirty three (33), E.W.M.

The public necessity for such road being as follows: There is no County road East-erly or westerly for two miles on the north or south of proposed road. This will let much traffic from the Co. road west to the Old Oregon trail east and over the mountain. Four miles of this proposed road are used by RFD No. 1. Three and one quarter miles are used by the school buss. The whole of it is sorely needed by both Indian congregations in getting to and from church especially in winter. Wheat south and west goes over this road to Mission.
