REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

In the Matter of the Viewing the proposed Road from Pendleton to the foot of Cabbage Hill in Umatilla County, Oregon.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to View this Road, beg to submit the following report;

Pursuant to your order, we met at Pendleton, Oregon, and the Viewers having qualified, we proceeded to view the said road as specified in our order.

We find that the road as surveyed by the Engineers of the Oregon State Highway to be a practicable route and will be a direct benefit to the Public, and we therefore respectfully recommend that the said road be opened as a public highway of Umatilla County.

We also find that the following lands will be made less valuable the sum given after each itemized piece, by reason of the establishing of the said road.

o E.W. McComas --\$300 and 4 wire fence and scarify present road and blade it.
o U 131 Tatshama 4.1 Acres - \$200.00 fence south side of road and scarify present road when new road is finished.

o U 31 Jennie Van Pelt 0.3 acre -\$60.00 and move present fence.
o U 208 Lollemash 0.3 " -\$45.00 and move present fence.

o J. Ramin > SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.8 Tp. 2N R 3E E.----\$45.00 and move present fence.
o U 70 Tatmea 0.8 ac.---\$70.00 and move present fence.

o SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.9 Tp.2N R 33E. ^{0.5ac.}----\$40.00 and move present fence. (Tribal Land)

o Umatilla Indian School Farm----\$250.00 fence each side-Put in stock pass. 3.7 ac.
