ORDER ADOPTING VIEWERS REPORT AND ESTABLISHING ROAD

Now on this 8th day of March, 1918, comes on for consideration in open court the report of the Board of County Road Viewers in the above entitled matter said report having been publicly read the second time before this Court on the 7th day of March, 1918, this being the first meeting of said board since the said second reading of said report, and the District Attorney of said County having advised the Board that the proceedings in said matter are correct as to form, and this Board having thereupon at this time duly proceeded to consider said report of said Board of County Road Viewers, and there being no objections or remonstrance filed in said matter, and the board being now fully advised relative thereto, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that there are sufficient reasons why said road should be established, and no petition for damages whatsoever having ever been presented or filed in said matter, and the Board having at this time duly considered the said report of said Board of County Road Viewers, and the recommendation attached to said report, and made a part thereof, and the Board of County Road Viewers having in their said report recommended that the said proposed road be established as a regular County Road, and this Court being fully satisfied that said road will be of great public utility, and the immediate opening of said road is of great public necessity, and the Court being fully advised, thereupon and therefor it is hereby

CONSIDERED, ORDERED And ADJUDGED that said report of said Board of County Road Viewers be, and the same is hereby adopted in full; that all the recommendations contained in said report be, and the same are hereby adopted; that the said proposed road, as described in the original resolution herein, and as shown in the said recommendation attached to and made a part of said Road Viewers' report be, and the same is hereby established as a County Road and public highway, and that said road be finally surveyed and opened 40 feet in width, commencing at the NW corner of Section 18, Township 3 North, Range 33 EWM thence running in a Northeasterly and Northwesterly direction along the Eastern boundary line of the NP right of way and terminating on the West line of Section 7, Township 3 North, Range 33 at a point 312 feet North of the Southwest corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 7.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the present road along the West line of Section 18, Township 3 North, Range 33 EWM be vacated from the NW corner of said Section 18, except that so much of that road as lies in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 7, and in Section 12, Tp 3 N.R. 32 including the grade crossing over said railroad right of way, be not vacated.

In the Matter of County Road No. 786 petitioned for by W. A. Leathers, et al

ROAD NO 786

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February, 1918 term of this court to view, survey, and report upon said proposed County Road, the same having been publicly read on two different days at the same term of Court, to wit: Having been publicly read the first time on March 6, 1918, and publicly read the second time on March 7, 1918, and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, and the board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said proposed road be established, and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be, and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
