Notice is hereby given that the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners had initiated proceedings for the legalization of a portion of Despain Gulch Road, County Road #1000, lying in Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, Township 4 North, Range 30 E.W.M. and Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 31 E.W.M., approximately 9 miles northeast of Stanfield.
The Umatilla County Board of Commissioners, under authority of ORS 368.201 to 368.221 intends to hold a public hearing on the legalization of the road as traveled and used for ten (10) years or more on August 4, 2004, at 10:30 a.m. in Room 114, Umatilla County Courthouse, Pendleton, Oregon. Any persons wishing to be heard on this subject may attend this hearing in person or submit to the Department of Public Works in writing any appropriate information for consideration by the Board of Commissioners, who subsequently will determine whether the road shall be legalized.
