the undersigned and others, to the

County in the State of Oregon, at the
next regular term thereof at one
o'clock P.M. on the 10th day of April
A.D. 1884, Asking that a County Road
be duly located and opened on the
following described lines to wit

Beginning at a point where the East
line of Section thirty five (35) Town-
ship four (4) North of Range thirty (30)
East of Willamette Meridian crosses
a County Road, running down.

What is known as Stage Canyon
Thence North to a point ~~which is~~
